Award: Professor Johann DeBeer, Executive Chairman; List Premier

The Executive Chairman of **List Premier**, Professor Johann DeBeer, was inaugurated as Honorary Professor at the North China Institute for Science and Technology (NCIST) in Beijing, on the 30th August 2011.
